

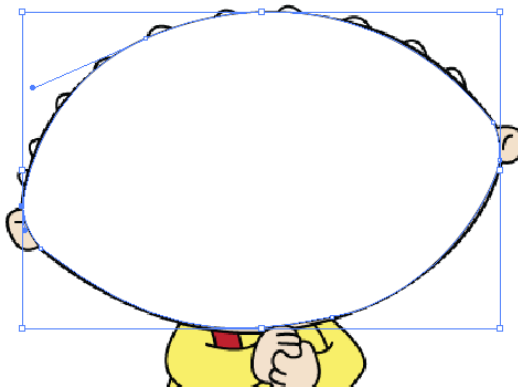





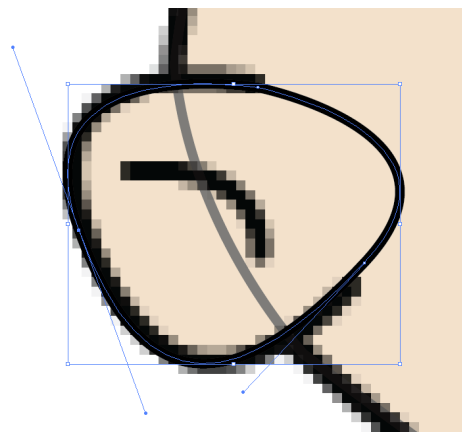
1. Open Illustrator
2. Grab the stewie picture from the website and drag it on your screen from the desktop
3. Center Stewie in the middle of the page by hitting this button.
 - a. 
4. Then select him again and center him- with this button
 - a. 
5. Select the picture and go to Object> Lock> Selection
6. With the Pen tool- outline stewies head- DO NOT WORRY ABOUT HIS EARS!

7. With stewies head still selected change the OPACITY to 60%
8. With the head still selected click on the fill section
 - a. Make sure you click on NO FILL
 - b.

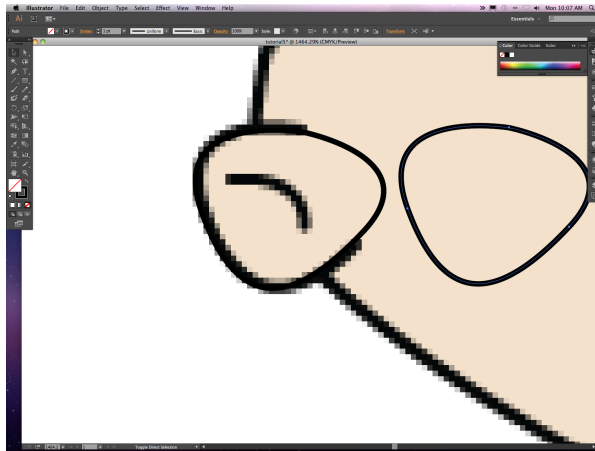

 10.  Make sure that this box is on top
 - 11.
 - 12.
 13.  This is the no fill box- click on it
 - 14.

15. Trace the ear

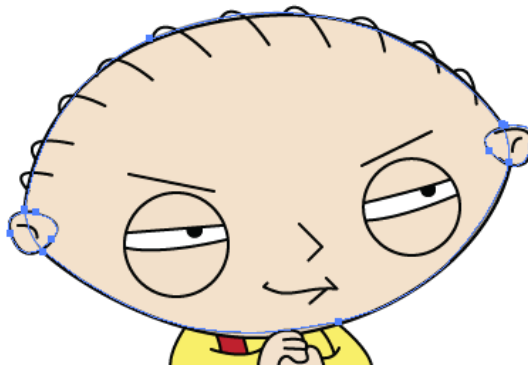

- b. Duplicate the ear by selecting it and pushing the option or alt key- a double arrow should come up- refer to last tutorial if you don't understand it.



- c. Take the copied ear and select it
d. Go to Object < Transform < Reflect-
i. Click on vertical and push ok
e. Move the reflected copy ear over to the correct spot.
f. Now select the head and the two ears

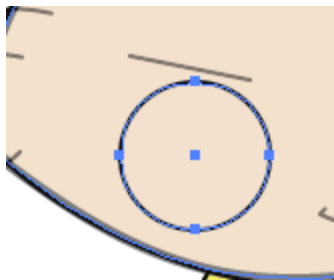


- g.
h. Go to Window < Pathfinder
i. Click on this button in the shape modes from the window that popped up. 
- j. Your ears should be attached to the head now-
- k. Click on the eyedropper tool 
- l. Click in the middle of the head of stewie- **Make sure that your head is still selected**

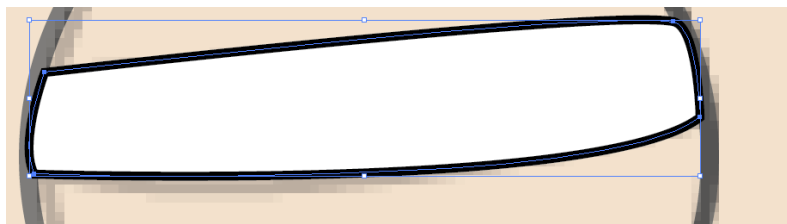

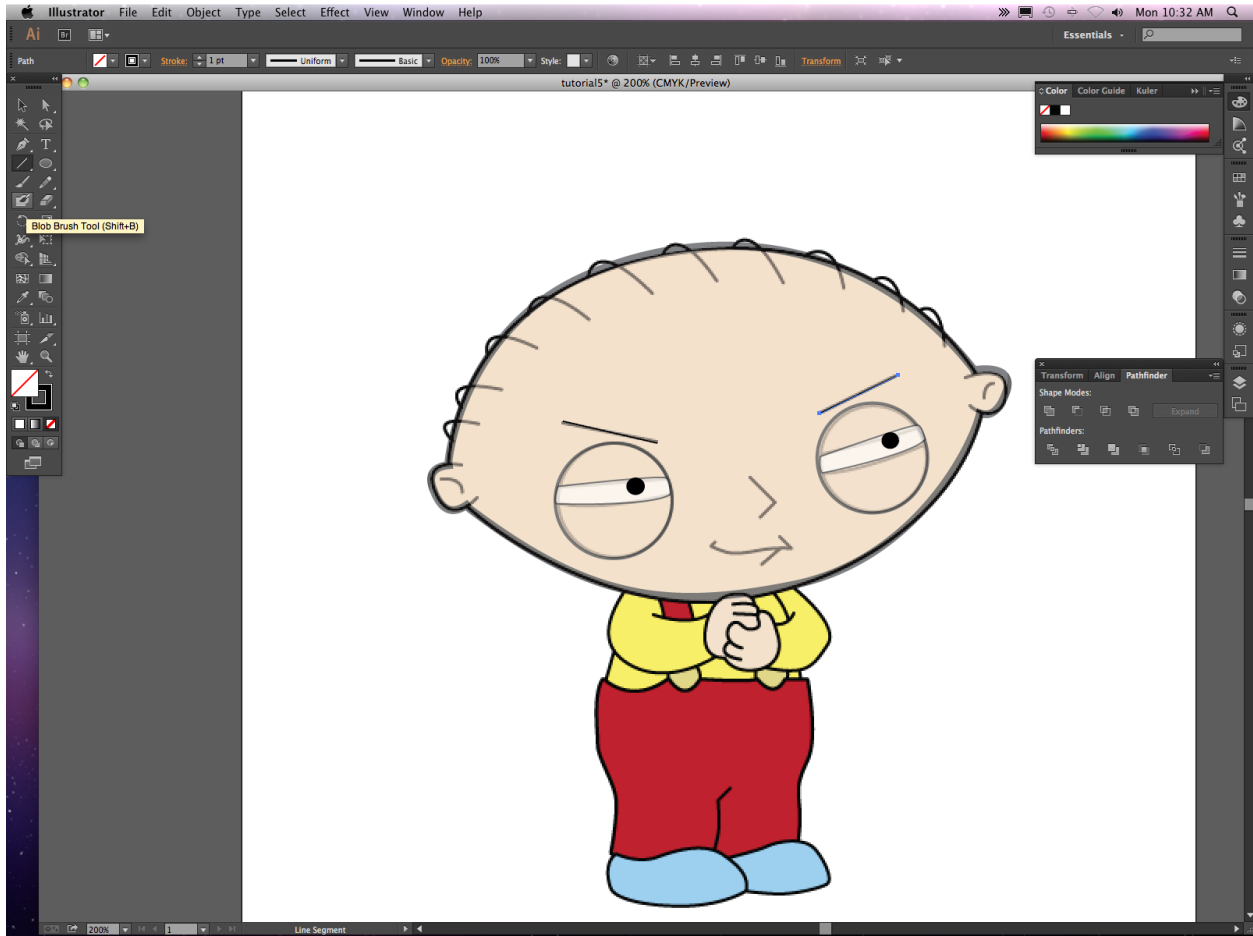
17. Go to the opacity button again and turn it to 60%
 - a. Make sure the outline is Black/ Stroke should be 4.
18. Go to the rectangle tool and click and hold on it- Click down on the ellipse tool
19. Cover stewies eye with a circle-




20. Go to the opacity and change it to 60%
21. Then make the middle of the eye- Zoom in to the eye very closely- trace the middle of the eye- have the fill be white and the outline black. Make sure the stroke is 2



22. Once finished change the opacity to 60%
23. Create the eyeball-
24. Then click on the eye, the white middle part and the eyeball holding down shift the entire time
25. Press command or apple G to group the eye together
26. Repeat step 15b with the entire eyeball and move it so it fits.



27. With the line segment tool make stewie's eyebrows 
28. With the pen tool make his nose- remember to click on the selection arrow to de-select the pen tool.
29. With the paintbrush tool, paint his hair, inside ears and mouth.
30. Push shift and click on all the lines you created with the paintbrush- They should all be selected- refer to last tutorial if you don't understand.
31. Go to the stroke button and push .5 for hair to be smaller.
32. select entire face and move the opacity to 100%
 - a. Eyes should not be 100%
 - b. Triple click on the eyelid- once it is in isolation mode move your opacity to 100%
 - c. Do this with the middle of the eye as well. Duplicate step b and c for the other eye.
 - d. We will finish stewies body next time for tutorial 6.
